**Rules and Regulations** 

- Contestant must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of Texas and a member of a Bowie County
   4-H Club or FFA (Future Farmers of America).
- ❖ Contestant must be between the ages of 8 and 18 years of age as of January 1, of the contest year. Student MUST be enrolled in high school for the year of her reign.
- Princess contestants will be students enrolled in 3-8 grades, and queen contestants will be enrolled in 9-12 grades.
- Candidates must be single, never have been married, have had no children, and must not marry nor become pregnant during her reign.
- ❖ A current 5 x 7 photograph of applicant must accompany the application. Photos should not be attached to applications. Photocopies are not acceptable. Photos and applications will become property of the Bowie County Market Livestock Show and will not be returned.
- Contest interviews will be held on Tuesday, September 9th at the New Boston High School Auditorium.
- Please dress in appropriate contest attire.
- ❖ Your appearance is an important part of your overall score. Please dress accordingly.
  - No flip-flops.
  - No bare midriffs or low-cut tops
  - No clothing with advertising logos or inappropriate messages
- ❖ Appearance will be expected to be maintained throughout reign as well.

- ❖ A panel of nonpartisan judges will interview contestants. Interviews will last approximately 15 minutes.
- Applicants will be judged in the following areas: poise, personality, responses, appearance, presentation and participation in school, community and her organization's activities.
- NO INTERVIEWS WILL BE HELD AT ANY OTHER TIME OR PLACE.
- Any documented behavior that reflects badly on the Queen, Princess, her school, or the Bowie County Market Show will be asked to relinquish her title and the 1<sup>st</sup> runner up will take over her duties and responsibilities.
- Prizes will include: <u>Queen</u>- Sash, Crown, Trophy, and Buckle <u>Princess</u>- Sash, Crown, Trophy, and Buckle
  1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up and Miss Congeniality trophies will be awarded in each division.
- ❖ If the current Queen is unable to complete her reign, the title will be passed to the first runner-up.
- ❖ The Queen and runners-up are required to attend both (2) days of the 2014 Bowie County Fair, held Thursday, February 26 through Friday, February 27.
- ❖ They will be required to make appearances, present awards and attend major functions as deemed mandatory by the Bowie County Fair Queen Committee.
